

Chocorua Camping Village, located in Tamworth N.H., was recently recognized by the National Association of RV Parks and Campgrounds, (ARVC), during its 2006 National Convention in Orlando FL as the mid-sized Park of the Year.

The Board of Directors of ARVC, which represents over 4000 member campgrounds and RV (Recreational Vehicle) Parks across the country, selects each year one campground to receive, this, the most prestigious national award in the Campground & RV Park Industry.
